2015 Christmas Appeal!

This year we will be running two Christmas appeals, both for St Vincent de Paul, but each supporting different needs.

All grades will receive two laundry baskets. One basket will be dedicated to collecting Christmas food items to support our own parish Vinnies chapter.

They have specifically asked us as a community to help them during this time as the need is great and their supplies are very low. We are hoping to collect non-perishable Christmas food that can offer struggling families a happy Christmas meal together.

The second basket is dedicated to collecting toiletries for the Matthew Talbot Hostel for Men. This is an appeal that we have run over the last few years and that we feel has been very beneficial for students. Students are able to see the real needs of the homeless and have been able to contribute in a meaningful and tangible way. Items such as toothpaste, combs and thick socks can be luxury items to the needy, where we often take them for granted. Collecting items such as these can make a real difference for those who are sleeping rough.

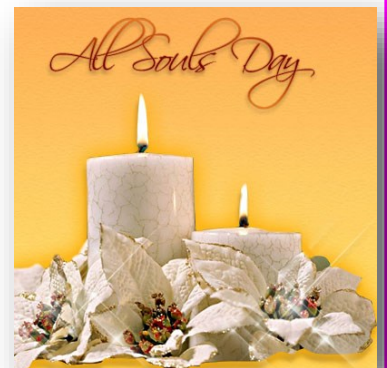


Year 6 Reflection Day
