IMPORTANT EVENTS COMING UP AT HOLY CROSS



All proceeds will go directly to Claire and her family.



One part of our 20th Anniversary celebration during Week 8 will be our school Skip-a-Thon on **Friday, September 13th.** This will involve the students participating in various skipping challenges and routines that will build upon the skills being taught in our Monday skipping program led by MultiSport.
